THE JOB:

Under the direction of the Public Works Supervisor and/or Crew Leader, performs a wide variety of semi-skilled public works maintenance duties that includes the use of light to heavy equipment in all weather conditions. Responds to emergencies such as auto accidents, weather emergencies including heavy snow and trees down as needed.

JOB DUTIES:

Performs maintenance on streets, sidewalks, and signs. Includes stripping asphalt patching and concrete work, landscaping tree trimming/removal, grass and brush cutting. Also responsible for maintenance on the water and sewer systems including the pumping and lift stations, repair water main breaks, sewer force main breaks, as well as failures of valve, hydrants, buffalo-boxes, manholes and catch basins. Performs maintenance on streetlights and traffic signals. Operates a variety of light and heavy equipment. Operates snow and ice abatement equipment and takes shifts on the snow fighting team. Must be available for emergency call-outs after hours and in all weather conditions.

KNOWLEDGE/EDUCATION/EXPERIENCE:

Must have a High School Diploma or GED. Specialized training and trade school in any of the following areas: Masonry, Electrical, Mechanical Maintenance or Pipefitting. Knowledge and operating ability of light and heavy equipment, as well as snow plows. Must have a valid Commercial driver's license with air brake endorsement. Utility or construction experience is preferred.

SKILLS:

The ability to work independently without direct supervision. Must be able to work in a fast-paced environment. The ability to provide customer service to the residents in a helpful, polite manner. Good verbal and written communication skills.

ADA REQUIREMENTS:

Must be able to hear, speak and see. Must be able to walk, sit, stand, and kneel. Must be able to grasp with hands as well as push and pull often. Must be able to lift up to 40 lbs. from waist to above shoulder and from waist to the ground seldom
